North American Names Trio to Key Tulsa Posts

Appointments of three veteran North American Aviation employees to key positions in the firm's new Tulsa plant were announced Tuesday by R. F. Walker, vice president and general manager of the Space & Information Systems division plant.

The three are James L. Barker, factory manager; Gordon E. Suess, accounting manager, and Marshall Mowrey Jr., industrial security manager.

Barker has served in manufacturing functions since he joined North American 24 years ago. Prior to accepting his new position he was manufacturing project superintendent for the B70 at the Los Angeles division.

Previously he had been manufacturing superintendent on the F107, and also has worked on the F100 and the T39.

Suess, who has been with the company seven years, was a member of the internal control staff at North American's general offices before going to the Space and Information Systems division.

He is a certified public accountant in California.

Mowrey was assistant director of industrial security at the company's Columbus, Ohio, division before accepting his Tulsa assignment. A nine-year company
