CIA Aide Feared Lakonia Victim

Dennis W. Vernon, 34, a Central Intelligence Agency employe and former Arlington resident, has been listed among the victims of the Lakonia cruise ship disaster.

A CIA spokesman said Vernon, who was vacation-bound on the Greek liner when it burned 10 days ago and sank in the Atlantic off Madeira, is one of the missing or unidentified dead.

Vernon, who lived in Arlington while serving with CIA in Washington from 1956 to 1960 had been stationed in London for the past four years as an information specialist.
