Jury Indicts Man Accused In Swindle

A man who allegedly posed as a CIA agent to swindle a 19-year-old coed out of \$7,899 was indicted by a federal grand jury here today.

Carl Ekelof, 40, told the coed the money would be used to help the CIA in its fight against Castro, said Assistant U. S. At-

torney Lloyd G. Bates Jr.

Bates said Ekelof, alias Carl F. Karlstrom, met Mary Ann Hutch at the 79th Street shopping center in 1962 and told her he was a CIA agent.

Miss Hutch, a student at Barry College, was told she had a

reputation as a girl who would fight for freedom, Bates said.

Ekelof induced her to withdraw money from a joint account shared with her father, the prosecutor said.

Ekelof's was one of 50 indictments returned by the federal grand jury today.
