KINGSTON, JAMAICA, NOV. 21 (REUTERS)-LORD MORRISON OF LAMBETH, 76-YEAR-OLD BRITISH PARLIAMENTARIAN, SUGGESTED AT THE COMMONWEALTH PARLIAMENTARY ASSOCIATION (CPA) CONFERENCE HERE TODAY THAT NON-ALIGNMENT IS AN INVITATION TO AGGRESSION.

DIRECTING HIS REMARKS TO NON-ALIGNED MEMBERS OF THE BRITISH COMMONWEALTH LORD MORRISON SAID, "IF EVERY COUNTRY WAS NONALIGNED, AND THERE WAS NO COLLECTIVE SECURITY . . . WOULD IT NOT BE AN INVITATION TO AN AGGRESSOR TO AGGRESS?"

APPLAUSE DROWNED HIS VOICE AS HE SAID THAT WHEN MALAYSIA WAS ATTACKED BY INDONESIA "BRITAIN, AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND SAID 'WE ARE ALIGNED.' THEY HOLD THEIR HEADS ERECT AND ARE PROUD THAT THEY CAME TO HELP."

EARLIER RICHARD CLEAVER, AN AUSTRALIAN DELEGATE, TOLD AFRICAN DELEGATES "A FEW LESS WORDS ABOUT AFRICA AND A FEW MORE WORDS OF POSITIVE SUPPORT FOR ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE COMMONWEALTH UNDER ATTACK MIGHT HAVE BEEN MORE IN ORDER."

THE MINISTER OF WORKS FOR TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, SAIED MOHAMMED, URGED THE CONFERENCE TO ASSIST MALAYSIA. HE SAID INDONESIA'S ATTACKS WERE "A CHALLENGE TO THE COMMONWEALTH AND ALSO A CHALLENGE AND AFFRONT TO THE DEMOCRATIC WAY OF LIFE."

DEREK JAGAN, THE BRITISH GUIANA DELEGATE, TONIGHT ATTACKED U.S. POLICY TOWARD HIS COUNTRY, ALLEGING THAT AMERICAN CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENTS WERE "VERY ACTIVE" AND THAT "AMERICANS DON'T LIKE OUR SOCIALIST POLICY."

HE TOLD THE CPA CONFERENCE THAT "ALTHOUGH BRITISH GUIANA IS A BRITISH COLONY, SHE FEELS THAT THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT HAS MORE TO SAY ABOUT HER FUTURE."

JAGAN CLAIMED PROPORTIONAL REPRESENTATION SYSTEM WAS INTRODUCED INTO HIS COUNTRY'S POLITICS "WITH THE SOLE HOPE OF ENSURING THE DEFEAT OF THE PEOPLE'S PROGRESSIVE PARTY, WHICH HAS SURVIVED THREE ELECTIONS."

HIS CHARGES WERE IMMEDIATELY REBUTTED BY UNITED KINGDOM DELEGATE DONALD CHAPMAN WHO DECLARED: "WE FEEL IT IS WRONG FOR THIS NATION TO GO FURTHER AND FURTHER INTO RACIAL CONFLICT."
HE SAID IT WAS HOPED A COALITION OF BOTH RACES WILL RESULT.
