YESTERDAY A SERGEANT ACCUSED OF DESERTING THE U.S. ARMY AND SERKING
POLITICAL ASYLUM IN CUBA.

FBI AGENTS PROMPTLY PLACED SGT. ROBERT JOB KRESEE, 28. UNDER ARREST WHEN HE LANDED HERE ABOARD A REGULAR CONMERCIAL AIRLINER FROM HAVANA.
HE WAS HELD IN THE DADE COUNTY JAIL PENDING A SEARING TODAY BEFORE A
U.S. COMMISSIONER.

WESLEY GRAPP, SPECIAL AGENT IN CHARGE OF THE MIANT PBI OFFICE.
SAID KEESEE FACED CHARGES OF DESERTION, AIRPLANE THEFT IND AUTOMOBILE
THEFT.

KEESEE, OF AMARILLO, TEX.. IS CHANGED IN A FEDERAL WARRANT ISSUED IN ALBUQUEROUS, N.M., WITH RENTING A SWALL PLANE THERE AND FLYING IT TO HAVANA, VIA KEY WEST, LAST MARCH 23. CUBAN OF ICIALS KEPT THE PLANE, THE FBI SAID.

NO ONE KNEW KEESEE HAD GONE TO CUBA UNTIL TO CUBAN RADIO ANNOUNCED THE NEXT DAY THAT HE HAD LANDED AT HAVANA AND AS TO FOR POLITICAL ASYLUM. HE WAS CHARGED WITH DESERTION FROM THE ARMY, THE UBI SAID, AFTER HE FAILED TO RETURN TO FORT HAUCHUCA, APT. JAN. 34 AT THE END OF A TWO-WEEK LEAVE.

HE IS ALSO CHARGED WITH STEALING A 1962 CAS THE BENTED IN PHOENIX, ARIZ., JAN. 19 AND ABANDONES ABVERAL NEED LATER AT BAN ANTONIO.

THE REI SAID KEESER TOLD AGENTS WHO QUESTIND HIM AFTER HIS ARREST THAT WHEN HE ARRIVED IN CUBA HE WAS PUT IN PRESAMENT OF THERE 49 DAYS.
HE WAS "EXTENSIVELY INTERROGATED BY DIFFERENT DRAW OF THE CUBAN GOVERNMENT." THE FRI SAID.

GRAPP SAID THAT YESTERDAY MORNING, "WITEGET TO MOTIFICATION,"
COBAN AUTHORITIES HAD KESSEE'S BEARD SHAVED OF LORD HIN TO TAKE
A SHOWER AND PUT ON CLEAN CLOTHES, THEN POT HIN SO THE PLIGHT
TO MIAMI.
