Radio 'Free Europe' Picks Right Guy

CHICAGO — The head of the national Fund Drive for Radio Free Europe, heads an anti-labor firm, has been one of the main speakers at the Military forums which have been under attack in Congress and is an intimate associate of the sponsors of the nation's largest anti-labor blacklist agency.

He is Charles H. Kellstadt, board chairman of Sears Roebuck & Co. His firm is the target of a nationwide AFL-CIO boycott because it discharged union members from their job and has refused to bargain with trade unions.

Kellstadt was one of the main speakers at the Military-Industrial conference sponsored by the Institute for American Strategy last year. This conference was attended by large numbers of military officers and top industrialists who mapped out a program to influence the American people along cold war lines.

Sears Roebuck is one of the main sponsors of the American Security Council, a private blacklist agency with its national headquarters in Chicago. Almost all of the employees are former FBI agents and its president John M. Flier was the former "security" officer for Sears Roebuck.
