### CIA and Radio Free Europe

The recent disturbing news about the involvement of the C.I.A. in allegedly independent student activities prompts me to call to the attention of the public a related matter.

The Radio Free Europe, Inc., which over the last 16 years has been repeatedly identified as an organization of the C.I.A., has been, according to the indications available, all too often engaged in propagating and promoting racial and religious prejudice.

It has employed and supported a number of former politicians from East Europe who were active in the racial persecutions of their native countries; it has supported and brought out a number of

been active in establishing leadership within certain ethnic groups of America and maintaining a foreign-language press in this country which can be best described as representing the ideas of racial hatred.

These activities of Radio Free Europe have remained mainly unknown to the American public because of the language barriers. But at present, when President Johnson is closing out many objectionable programs of the C.I.A., it would be highly desirable to close out the racist propaganda of Radio Free Europe and sever all those ties that the C.I.A. has with organizations propagating racial and religious hatred.
