

Dulles Says Nixon Errs About Cuba

Washington, March 21 (AP)
—Allen W. Dulles, former director of the Central Intelligence Agency, says Richard Nixon was in error when he charged that President Kennedy had been briefed during the 1960 campaign on Cuban invasion preparations.

Dulles said, however, he be-lieved the charge—contained in Nixon's new book, "Six Crisis" in —was the result of "an honest inlaunderstanding."

Nixon contended President

Kénnedy had been told the CIA

was helping to train Cuban
rebels for an invasion and had

Jeopardized the plan in campaign oratory.
