LONDON, FEB. 26-(REUTERS)-AN OPPOSITION LABOR PARTY MEMBER TODAY DEMANDED THE GOVERNMENT INSIST THE UNITED STATES STOP THE "ILLEGAL AND INTOLERABLE" USE OF HONG KONG FOR SMUGGLING EXPLOSIVES FROM FORMOSA INTO SOUTHERN COMMUNIST CHINA.

FORMER LABOR GOVERNMENT COMMONWEALTH SECRETARY PHILIP NOEL-BAKER ASKED COLONIAL SECRETARY NIGEL FISHER IF IT WAS NOT A FACT THAT NATIONALIST CHINESE ACTIVITIES ARE "FINANCED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AND MEN TRAINED BY THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY?"

FISHER SAID IT WAS "ABSOLUTE NEWS" TO HIM IF THIS WERE TRUE. HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT DEPLORED "THESE ACTIVITIES AND OF COURSE WE HAVE MADE REPRESENTATIONS THROUGH SUCH CHANNELS AS ARE AVAILABLE TO US IN FORMOSA."

NOEL-BAKER SAID IT WAS COMMON KNOWLEDGE THE NATIONALIST CHINESE GOVERNMENT WAS FINANCED BY THE U.S. AND THEIR TROOPS AMERICAN-TRAINED.

"ARE WE NOT ENTITLED TO ASK THEM AS AN ALLY -- AND INSIST -- THAT THIS ILLEGAL USE OF BRITISH-RULED TERRITORY SHALL COME TO END," HE SAID.

FISHER SAID THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT HAD REPORTED THE DETENTION OF 21 NATIONALIST CHINESE AGENTS AND THE SEIZURE 144 POUNDS OF EXPLOSIVES AND 7-1/2 POUNDS OF NAPALM THIS YEAR.
