The Red Cross said here that The Red Cross sald there that he 65-year-old Yonkers, N. Y., woman would visit her son for two weeks in mid-October. Mr. Redmond, 43, who was in the export-import business in Shanghaf, was jailed in 1951 on charges of being an "undercover agent." dercover agent."

Mrs. Redmond, who visited her son in 1958 and last September, asked the Red Cross ast month to arrange the new visit with the Chinese Red Cross Society. As in the past the Chinese Red Cross will ar-range for Mrs. Redmond's liv ing accommodations, travel an visits to the prison where he son is serving a life sentence
