

### Yonkers Woman Finds Son In Chinese Jail Looks 'Well'

PEKING, Oct. 23 (Reuters)

Mrs. Ruth Redmond of Yonkers, N. Y., said today that she found her son Hugh "looking fairly well" when she visited him yesterday in a Shanghai prison. He is serving a life sentence on a Communist Chinese espionage charge.

Mrs. Redmond, 65-year-old widow, said in a telephone interview from her hotel in Shanghai, where she arrived Sunday, that she spent two hours with her son yesterday. It was her first visit with him in more than four years.

"He looked fairly well," she said. He was in good spirits and was very happy to see me."

Mr. Redmond, a former employe of an import-export concern, has been in jail in Shanghai for 11 years. He is one of four Americans being held in Chinese jails.
