

Mother Of Captive Enters Red China

Hong Kong, Friday, Oct. 19 (AP)—

Mrs. Ruth Redmond, of Yonkers, N.Y., entered Communist China today to visit her imprisoned son in Shanghai.

The 65-year-old American widow, who has come half-way around the world to see her son, crossed the border at 11.37 A.M.

She was taken from her hotel to the border in a private car by representatives of the British Red Cross and American consulate general here.

Mrs. Redmond is expected to take a train to Canton and there board a plane for Shanghai.

The son, Hugh Francis Redmond, a former business man in Shanghai, has served eleven years of a life sentence on charges of espionage. He will be 43 October 30.
