

Woman Going to China To Seek Son's Release

YONKERS, July 21 — Mrs.

Ruth Redmond of 14 Argyle Terrace will leave New York by plane on Aug. 7 to visit her son, Hugh, a prisoner in Red China, and to make a personal appeal for his freedom. Arrangements for the trip, her second one, were made by the Yonkers Redmond Release Committee, headed by Sol Friedman, a lawyer. Mr. Redmond, who is now 43 years old, was swized in Shan hai on April 26, 1951, on espionage charges and has been a prisoner ever since.
