ADM. RABORN WORKED FOR POLARIS MANUFACTURER

DREW PEARSON: "Washington:-- In contrast to Admiral William Raborn, who helped develop the polaris missile and then went to work for the company which manufactures the polaris, General David Shoupe, ex-commander of the Marine Corps, has not gone to work for any defense contractor. He's available for government service. However, General Shoupe has not been appointed to high position. Admiral Raborn, a part of the military-defense-contractor alliance, which Eisenhower warned against, has been made Director of Central Intelligence."
