## MEMORAHDUM FOR: DIRECTOR OF INTELLIGENCE DEPARTMENT OF THE AIR FORCE

STBJEGT :

Production of Scientific Intelligence in the Field of Biology

1. As a result of recent informal conversations between members of the scientific branches of CIA and the IAC agencies relative to biological warfare intelligence, it appears feasible and advisable in view of the common concern in the production of intelligence in the field of biology that a series of informal interdepartmental meetings be arranged.

2. This effice believes that such meetings should be attended by representatives qualified to constitute a working committee on BY imbelligence. This committee would have as its objectives:

a. The proparation of an interdepartmental plan for the production of BW intelligence including the formula tion of reguirements, an appreisal of departmental capabilities for effective collection action, the allocation of responsibilities for production by various agencies participating in the separate fields of inquiry and the coordinating measures requisite to insure must effective utilization of available talent to the and that everlapping duplication is reduced to the maximum prestical extent.

b. The undertaking of a BW intelligence project which is designed to appraise and interpret in a single report all Malagianl intelligence available to the Federal Government, in order that the extent of our present knowledge can be contained in a single document, available to operational, planning and policy-making personnel, and that the intelligence agencies concerned may have a basic frame of reference on which to plan further production in this field.

5. It is therefore requested that your office designate or arrange for a qualified representative in the field of BM intelligence (Major F. A. Bass of the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, Material, and Major W. F. Sheeley of the Office of the Air Surgeon are suggested), to attend the series of meetings for the purpose of accomplishing the above stated objectives, the first of which is to be held on 4 October 1948 at 1000 hours in Room 2519, Temporary "M" Building. It is further requested that the attached forms, on which will be indicated the mames of the representatives of your department, be returned to this office at the earliest practical date.
