1. During the last weeks of June, the emergency phase of the [REDACTED] came to an end, and the personnel lent to the operation by the Office of Training have by now returned to the United States. As has already been indicated in ORR's memorandum of 21 June 1952 to the Director of Training, the Division of Techniques and Methods wishes to take this occasion specifically to commend trainees [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] for their excellent performance throughout this operation. Faced with a new type of work -- unrelated to any previous experience on their part and accompanied by the particular difficulties of an emergency overseas operation, they have not only performed their job thoroughly and well, but have also, on their own initiative, concentrated additional time and attention on the underlying problems and objective of the program as a whole. To quote the D/T liaison officer in [REDACTED] "They have worked much harder than could have been required or expected; they put not only their bodies but especially their minds to work overtime."

2. For effective performance, it was necessary for personnel to display leadership, planning capacity, and ability to deal with people in circumstances where successful public relations and team cooperation were of major importance. It was also necessary to work under great time pressure without sacrifice of quantity or quality of output and to possess a considerable degree of mechanical aptitude, particularly in order to appreciate the bearing of [REDACTED] on the analytic content of the work. There were of course variations between different members of the group as regards each of these points, but on balance all personnel were more than satisfactory in possessing the combination of qualifications required.

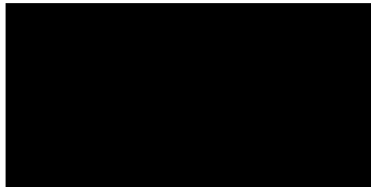
