

As indicated in our memorandum there is no agency that collates the intelligence pertaining to the ^{foreign} illicit traffic in arms. The questions to be decided before any recommendations can be made are:

1. Does CIA consider the subject of foreign illicit traffic in arms of such importance as to affect the national security of the U.S.?

2. If CIA undertakes the collation of this material for the [redacted] will it contribute to the security of the U.S.?

3. If CIA undertakes the collation of this material would ~~it~~ it want to pass it to [redacted]

4. Could the collation of this material be done more effectively in one of the IAC agencies?
