I am returning herewith Mr. Erlich's memorandum. I would agree that the possibilities of reverting to a Henry Hazlitt type of free enterprise economy after the event he analyzes are nil. It does not seem to me, however, that the pessimistic conclusions he draws from this are as inevitable as he implies. It is this thought on just what might be done in the economic sphere, among others, that I was trying to urge upon Walt last Friday.
