MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director of Science and Technology

SUBJECT : Revised Personnel Ceilings

REFERENCE : OSA-2684-69 dated 1 Oct 69; Subject: Military Personnel Requirements

1. In response to your memo of 2 January 1970 an extensive examination has been made of our organizational structure vis-a-vis our operational mission for 1971. To meet the requirement of reducing the overall ceiling of OSA by six positions when at the same time a new operational function; [redacted] is being absorbed has presented a difficult personnel manning problem. 25X1

2. During the past few months OSA has absorbed a total of fourteen (14) slots to accommodate operational commitments of the Office. These slots which are described in more detail in Ref. are:

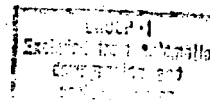
Looking forward to fiscal 1971, an additional twelve (12) positions will be needed to accommodate the field element of Project [redacted]. This figure has been reduced from an original estimate of eighteen (18) positions because 18 positions is too burdensome a number to accommodate from within the OSA ceiling. Our currently projected plan identifies the following deletions in order to augment the [redacted] strength:
