5. (Confidential - JGO) Met with Ralph Preston, Staff Assistant, House Appropriations Committee, and delivered to him the academic training report for FY 1969 through 1973. After reviewing the report, Preston asked if we would supplement it with a breakdown of the disciplines covered in the full time training.

Preston told me the Committee will be reporting the Defense appropriation bill to the House on 26 November after their return from the Thanksgiving recess.

Preston noted in passing that the Middle East atlas had been wellreceived and asked if we could provide twelve more copies for Committee use.

Preston told me that no consideration was given to the intelligence community as an entity in final mark-up of the Defense budget although a small amount of R&D money was taken from DIA, the reductions assessed were overall percentages to DOD for application by DOD to the various Defense agencies.
