13. [redacted] JMM) Met with Chairman F. Edward Hebert, House Armed Services Committee, and told him of the Director's appearance this morning before the Inter-American Affairs Subcommittee of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, and of Representative Harrington's questions and complaints regarding the Director's refusal to discuss sensitive operational matters.

I told Hebert of the request by Representatives Whitehurst and Daniel for a briefing on [redacted] He said he would have no objection to our providing them with a "low key" briefing on the subject.

In response to my question, Hebert said the Nedzi report had now been completed and there was nothing in it we should get terribly upset about but there were some things in it we would not like. He said we had to recognize Nedzi had a problem with his liberal colleagues and we couldn't expect a whitewash job. He said he thought it would be improper for us to see the report prior to its release.
