(Internal Use Only - JGO) Met with Herb Roback, Staff Director, House Government Operations Committee, and returned to him the Committee file on Colonel Joseph Christiano, an Air Force officer missing in action on a flight over Laos on 24 December 1965. Although I was unable to provide any substantive information on the case, I indicated other possible sources of information that had not been explored.

Hogan told me that Chairman Nedzi asked if a date has been set for return of a sterile version of the Committee transcripts of the Agency Watergate hearing. I told him that to my knowledge we have not undertaken any such review and that we have no present plans to do so. I thought it had been agreed that the transcripts would not be published. Hogan asked if I would take this up directly with Chairman Nedzi on Monday.
