[redacted] In connection with a cable from [redacted] (1) it was learned from Dick Aherne, State Department, that the courier bringing the 21 May Senate Foreign Relations Committee transcript had been delayed from Monday to today; (2) it was learned by Mr. O'Neill from the House Armed Services Committee that they do not intend to release Ambassador Helms' 17 May testimony unless State requests a copy of the transcript.
