

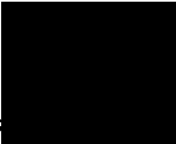

1. Spent the greater part of the day assisting Mr. Dulles in connection with transportation arrangements for [redacted] and [redacted] who are urgently needed in [redacted] on a special mission. Arranged for advances to each individual in the amounts of \$500.00 in cash, getting a passport for [redacted] obtaining [redacted] and making reservations and obtaining tickets for a flight from Washington to New York at 6:45 p.m. and for a flight from New York to [redacted] at 9:00 p.m. [redacted] departed for National Airport about 4:45 p.m.

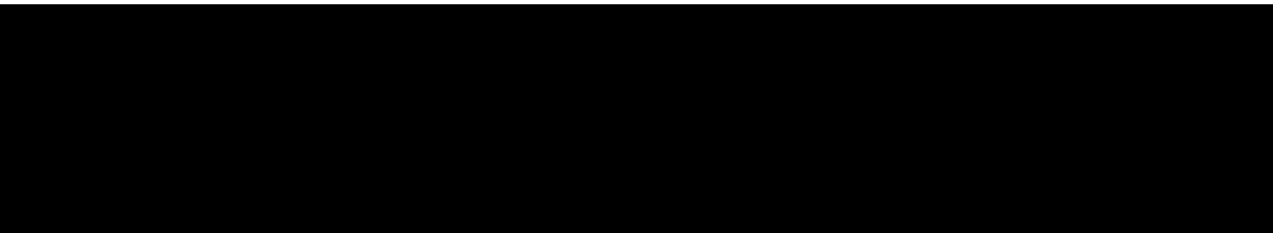
