Matt Baird advised me that the Logistics training film, "Interlock", would be shown in Room 153 of Building [REDACTED] at 11:45 a.m. on Wednesday and said that he hoped I could attend inasmuch as now that the film had been made [REDACTED] the DD/P monitor, believed that it was belittling to the Case Officer. 2. At the Senior Staff Meeting the Director spoke at some length about leaks and contacts with the press. He stressed particularly the requirement that all contacts with the press be reported to Colonel Grogan in accordance with [REDACTED] dated 6 January 1956 and asked that I redistribute this Notice as a reminder. 25X1A

5. Gordon Stewart and [REDACTED] were up to talk to me about the supergrade ceiling. We are getting very close to the [REDACTED] positions which we established previously. The DD/P Area is particularly close to its ceiling and Gordon proposed that we start immediately to consider promotions on an Agency-wide competitive basis. I told him that while this was all right theoretically it would be unfair to one component if another exceeded its ceiling and thereby blocked the first component from filling its authorized supergrade positions when it had someone ready to promote to them. I asked that he study the matter further before presenting it to the Supergrade Review Board and in this connection to come up with statistics on attrition in the various components and give some thought to what we were going to do when senior people who have been chiefs of station abroad return to headquarters. 25X1A9a
