7. Met with Shef, Gordon Stewart, and Larry Houston concerning our Security Hearing Boards. We agreed that we should not attempt to replace [redacted] in his capacity as Special Assistant to the DD/S for these matters; however, it was our belief that we should get a senior Agency official to take this on in addition to his other duties,

and the names of [REDACTED], Office of Basic Intelligence, [REDACTED] Office of Central Reference, and [REDACTED] of the Inspector General's Staff were considered likely candidates. We also felt that to bring the Office of Personnel into this would be an added burden for them without any corresponding benefits to the Agency as a whole. I agreed to discuss the matter with General Cabell at an early date. (I subsequently spoke to General Cabell who agreed as a matter of principle and preferred that we consider only Captain [REDACTED] and General [REDACTED] at this time. He approved of my discussing the subject with Messrs. Amory and Kirkpatrick and then with Captain [REDACTED] and General [REDACTED] if appropriate.)
