1. [redacted] telephoned to say that Ben Williams of the General Accounting Office had telephoned requesting a copy of their last audit report on ORR, together with all of the working papers. He feels that seven years is enough time to spend in that Division at headquarters and in the field; however, he is agreeable to another overseas assignment at any time and would prefer his next assignment to be in the Far East. He isn't particularly interested in going to any of the senior service schools.
