LEGISLATION Called Bob Belair, on the staff of the Domestic Council at the White House, and suggested that he discuss electronic surveillance with Brent Scowcroft, Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs, or his Deputy, Bill Hyland. Belair said that he hoped we would talk to him on the issue of electronic surveillance in any case and that he had already arranged sessions with DOD, NSA, Jim Wilderotter (at the White House), and Kevin Maroney (at the Justice Department).

10. LIAISON Marsha Matts, Defense Subcommittee, House Appropriations Committee staff, called and said that Ralph Preston, Staff Assistant, would like two more copies of the paper that Mr. Cary delivered to him on 11 November to be used in regard to allegations against CIA. I told her that I would pass this on to Mr. Cary.

11. LIAISON Called Mary Eby, in the office of Senator Robert C. Byrd (D., W. Va.), in response to her carlier inquiry and apologized for the slight delay in replying to Mr. Fitzwater's request concerning his past employment with the Agency and that the information would be submitted to him early next week. I said we would provide a courtesy copy to the Senator's office. (Apparently the information is needed to facilitate entry into the United States of a child from Southeast Asia, in whom Fitzwater has a special interest.)

12. ADMINISTRATIVE Mr. Charles Watson, OTR, advised that Senator Mike Gravel (D., Alaska) will be addressing the Senior Seminar on Tuesday, 18 November, from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m. He said Mr. Cary and Mr. Miller are invited to sit in. (This was arranged through of OTR who met Senator Gravel at a seminar a few weeks ago.)

13. INTELLIGENCE BRIEFING Randall Teague, in the office of Representative Jack Kemp (R., N.Y.), called and said he and a group of administrative and legislative assistants are going to South Korea either 20 or 21 November and wondered if they could could get a briefing from our people. Arrangements were made for 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 18 November in Room 135 Cannon House Office Building for and OCI, to conduct the briefing.
