1. [redacted] Delivered to the offices of Senators Edward M. Kennedy (D., Mass.), Henry M. Jackson (D., Wash.) and Jesse A. Helms (D., N.C.) [redacted] in which their names were mentioned

2. [redacted] Stopped by the office of Representative James H. Scheuer (D., N.Y.), and left a package of maps for Bob Samuels who requested them earlier.

3. [redacted] Met with Dottie, on the staff of Representative Jack Edwards (R., Ala.), and gave her a map of Kenya and explained to her the procedure for requesting maps from the Government Printing Office for constituents.

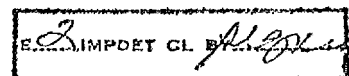
4. [redacted] Stopped by the office of Senator John V. Tunney (D., Calif.), and left with the receptionist suggested replies for a constituent who inquired about alleged Agency involvement in the Kennedy assassinations and also for [redacted] a frequent writer to people on the Hill and also to the Agency.

5. [redacted] Called Jane McMullan, Senate Appropriations Committee staff, and advised her that we had received the 30 April 1975 and 1 May 1975 transcripts of the Director's appearance before the Intelligence Operations Subcommittee of the Committee. She said they would call if they needed either of these transcripts.

6. [redacted] [redacted] a constituent of Representative Jonathan B. Bingham (D., N.Y.), called and inquired as to whether we had any additional information concerning [redacted] a Vietnamese evacuee. I told him we had no further information.

Following a call from [redacted] called [redacted] back and advised him that [redacted] name had appeared on an overall mission listing of persons to be evacuated from Vietnam. I told him there was a good chance he had managed to leave the country but we would not know anything definite until later in the week.

[REDACTED] Stopped by to see Ron Tammen, in the office of Senator William Proxmire, and delivered to him Dr. Proctor's letter to Proxmire on the subject of a briefing on the economic situation in North Vietnam, the PRC and North Korea. We talked about scheduling the briefings of the Joint Economic Committee on Soviet defense expenditures (I said this was what Proctor wanted to see Proxmire about) and of Proxmire's Appropriations Subcommittee on the Soyuz program. Tammen will call me with suggested dates.
