It was explained that in the interest of limiting the unnecessary proliferation of sensitive Agency information, we have for more than a quarter of a century preferred to deal directly with the committees rather than with them through the GAO and that we thought that any change in the method of operation should await the findings of the Select Committees who obviously will be faced with the problem of which institutions or committees of Congress should be provided access to the various types of information possessed by the Agency. Mr. Fascell was understanding of our position, was of a disposition to call off the GAO in this instance, at least until the issue is resolved, and in general said he was supportive of GAO assuming a greater role in support of the Congress. Mr. Fascell will talk to GAO and will then advise us of his decision.	25X1
