1. Reference is made to your memorandum, dated 29 September 1961, Subject as above, which provided two copies of the second of a series of CIA studies pertaining to Soviet Bloc covert psychological warfare studies. (C)
2. The study is a useful contribution to our counterintelligence reference literature and has been reviewed with interest and appreciation. We do not have any pertinent information to contribute at this time. (U)
3. This office has taken note of your requirements for information on further manifestations of the continued use of Sino-Soviet Bloc covert propaganda operations, including data on black surfacings and replays. We also have taken cognizance of your needs for physical evidence and detailed information concerning the appearances of hostile psychological warfare materials. In this connection, this office is desirous of providing OSI overseas directorates with copies of your study and instructions. For that purpose, it is requested that three additional copies of the study be made available to this office. These, and the extra copy previously furnished, would be provided to the OSI Directorates at Headquarters USAFE, PACAF, and the Caribbean and Alaskan Air Commands, together with the guidance and instructions contained in your letter. (S)
