DC/FE Support, suggested that SAVA might develop the matline for a briefing program designed to assist officers going to Saigon Station. In conversations with personnel from FB Division. and the IDI there appears to be no doubt in the value of a briefing program on Vietnam. I have explored some of the substantive and administrative details for such a briefing program. Classroom space in this building exists but whether or not it can be made available is in doubt. The Library has prepared an updating of their bibliography on Vietnam but there are limited copies of books svailable which would have to be corrected. Graphics Registry has a large library of films on Vietnam. some of which have been acreemed and appear useful for orientation purposes. OTH is villing to undertake the administration of a briefing program but would require considerable substantive assistance from FE Division. With the number of personnel programed for Victors during the maxt nine months it appears that if a briefing program is undertaken, it should occur about once a month with about cofficers in attendance. If it is decided that a briefing progress should be conducted, a decision which belongs with the Division and Branch, then the program should be sponsored by FE. SAVA may be able to assist the Branch in a staff capacity.
