In a conference which I had with [redacted] this morning, the following information was obtained;

1. [redacted] Teletypist, will not be approved for security, and it appears that regardless of the fact that I made a very strong plea for him on the basis of him being an excellent and dependable employee, it is a hopeless case. I requested that he not be dismissed prior to 1 April 1948 in order to allow me some time to recruit a replacement teletypist, which is already a difficult problem. This was agreed to tentatively and unless I hear further from [redacted], we must anticipate losing him on or about 1 April 1948.

2. [redacted] will not be approved for security. I offered no strenuous objections to her dismissal. In all probability we will lose her very shortly.

3. [redacted] will not be approved for security. I offered no strenuous objections to his dismissal, and it appears that there is a good chance that he will be dismissed in the near future.

4. [redacted] was also on the list for security disapproval. I made a rather strong plea in her case on the basis of her being an excellent typist and dependable employee. I believe that I was successful in forestalling this case, so we will forget about this possibility. I also cleared with [redacted] on her promotion to CAF-4, and if this has not been resubmitted, it should be resubmitted at once.

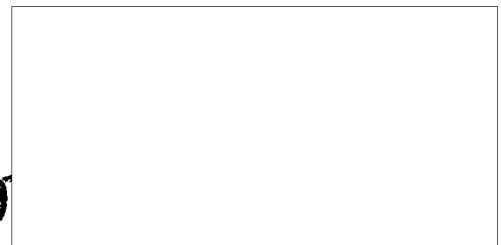
