MONITOR SERVICE TO QUIT PORTLAND

Los Angeles, Jan. 13 (AP)- The U. S. government's foreign broadcast information service announced Tuesday it will nove its radio monitoring station from Portland Op., to nearby Reseda, Cal., later this year "due to more advantageous local operating conditions."

The announcement said a new station will be completed and ready for use in March or April. It will employ about 50 persons, most of when will be transferred from the present Portland staff. The Oregon station has been in operation since October, 1941.

The Foreign breadcast monitoring service has been using facilities of the FOG monitoring service on N.E. 145th Ave. near Halsey street since early in World War II. The new Galifernia station has been constructed to provide equipment and quarters for the function separate from FCG, which will continue to maintain its station here as it did before the war.
