Caversham - Cairo coverage

- 1. Reference is made to memorandum to Chief, FBIB, B May 1948, subject as above. On the basis of recommendations therein and of FBIB planning of Mediterranean Bureau coverage, you are instructed to make the following interim arrangements:
  - a. Set up Hediterranean Bureau coverage schedule by priority of requirements, giving first priority to broadcasts completely unmonitored at Caverchem, and lowest priority to those monitored for local purposes only.
    - b. Discontinue coverage of all MRC broadcasts.
  - c. Continue coverage of all Bear and Middle Rast and Eastern European broadcasts lieted in item I of reference memorandum as possible duplications, reducing priority and avoiding duplication to the extent possible by co-ordinating with London Europea. These transmitters are all within Mediterranean Europea's proper coverage range, and should ultimately be handled in such manner that Caversham can discontinue monitoring them if desired.
  - d. Continue coverage, for the present, of Mescow broadcasts in Hear East languages listed in reference items, reducing priority and avoiding duplicate effort by queries to London Bureau and any other means cossible. This coverage may later be dropped if arrangements are worked out to produce from Caversham all desirable textual material. Above statement applies also to listed broadcasts from Leningrad and Tunis.
