SCHEDULE

SCOPE OF WORK

Under this Task Order No. 6 the Contractor shall furnish the necessary material and services for the development, fabrication and testing of a special paraboloidal antenna assembly feeds and mounting pedestal in accordance with Contractor's proposal dated 23 February 1958. Said specifications are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof. The above described work shall be completed and deliveries made within ninety (90) days from date of acceptance by the Contractor of this Task Order. Technical progress reports, final report, operating and installation manual and installation drawings shall be submitted at such times and in such format as may be specified by the Project Engineer of the Contracting Officer.

SECURITY

The program, equipment, and reports under this Task Order, unless associated with the sponsoring Government activity, are UNCLASSIFIED. In the event any question may arise during the preliminary phases of the work and/or research concerning the security of the technical aspects, i.e., security classification of various component parts and/or related reports connected thereto, the Project Engineer of the Contracting Officer is authorized to furnish security guidance during the interim period.
