- l. It is requested that the T/O of Foreign Documents Division be changed to authorize two additional GS 7-9 positions in the Eastern European Branch for two Serbo-Croat Translators.
- 2. This change is requested because the two Serbo-Croatian linguists now on duty in the branch are unable to handle expeditiously the volume of Serbo-Croat translation which is currently required by the Office of Special Operations, in addition to that which is needed by other offices of CTA. Details concerning the OSO requirements and FTA)'s capabilities are given in references a. and b., copies of which are attached.
- 3. According to the Assistant Director for Special Operations, "The present volume of reports in Serbo-Croat is expected to continue for the indefinite future". Volume is approximately 300 pages per month. In view of requirements from other offices, Foreign Documents Division is at present incapable of processing more than 100 pages per month for OSO. In order to fulfill the 300 page requirement, the addition of two Serbo-Croat translators to the Foreign Documents Division T/O will be necessary.
