MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence  
SUBJECT : Use of Patrol Dogs at New Building Site

1. This memorandum is for information only.
2. In order to provide for increased security during the final stages of construction of the New Building, it is planned to utilize trained dogs to assist the guards in after hours patrols. Two trained handlers with their dogs will be on duty at all times between 1800 hours and 0600 hours daily.
3. An abandoned cinder block building on the old anti-aircraft site is presently being renovated to provide a kennel. Five contract employees are undergoing eight weeks of training with the dogs. It is contemplated that the after hours dog patrols will commence on approximately 12 December 1960 and will continue until the entire building is occupied.
