Dear Sir:

It is my pleasure to inform you that the Joint Chiefs of Staff have allocated four student quotas in the Fifty-Eighth Class at the Armed Forces Staff College, to be filled by representatives of the Central Intelligence Agency. It is requested that you furnish the College with confirmation of your intended use of the quotas by 14 March 1975 in order to facilitate early distribution of any unused quotas.

The military officers attending the College are largely Majors/Lieutenant Commanders (middle management) with a small percentage (approximately 10%) having attained Lieutenant Colonel/Commander rank. Their average age is 36 years. Qualifications for DOD civilian students are that they be in grade GS-12 or above and preferably be in the 30-40 year age bracket. This information is furnished for your guidance, as it is considered appropriate that your nominees have reached a point in their career development paralleling that of our other students. All students must have Top Secret security clearances and your representatives must also possess a "Q" clearance from the Atomic Energy Commission. A delay of approximately ninety to one hundred twenty days may be anticipated after the Atomic Energy Commission receives such a request before a "Q" clearance is granted.

In order that the College may communicate directly with the selected nominees, the following information is requested by 4 April 1975.


- a. Names, grades, and complete mailing addresses.
- b. Statement confirming clearance for access to Top Secret information and "Q" clearance.

The reporting period for the Fifty-Eighth Class is 11-12 August 1975; the convening date is 18 August 1975; and the graduation date is 16 January 1976. Request that selectees be instructed to report to the College not later than 12 August 1975.

Quarters are available for both bachelor students and those attending with their families. Students desiring quarters should so indicate on the housing questionnaire which will be inclosed with the Commandant's welcome letter to the nominees. The allocation of on-station quarters to those students desiring them will be 15 June 1975.

Any questions or inquiries concerning your representatives' attendance at the College will be handled by my office, and we stand ready to assist you in any way we can.
