The Admissions Committee has completed its review of the applications for the September 1974 class of the Program for Management Development. Regrettably, the Committee has been unable to act favorably on your application. While this decision may be disappointing, I hope the following comments will help you understand the context in which it was reached.

The Faculty places great exphasis on having a diverse mix of students in order to facilitate the maximum exchange of ideas and optimize the learning experience. Consequently, the Admissions Committee spends considerable time in attempting to establish a PMD class balance of managerial functions, companies, and industrias. Accordingly, each applicant is considered not only on the basis of personal job qualifications and business experience, but also with regard to the mix of that particular class.

In addition, due to an extensive renovation program of PMD living facilities, the number of available spaces in the next sessions must be reduced. Since demand for the program has continued to grow, competition for spaces in the program has become much more intense.

We appreciate your interest in the Program for Management Development and wish you success in the future.
