MEMORANDUM FOR: Assistant Deputy Director (Administration)

SUBJECT: Military Personnel Requirements for the Remainder of Fiscal Year 1953 and for Fiscal Year 1954 (for DCI)

1. Military personnel requirements of this Agency for Fiscal Year 1954 are now being prepared for submission to the Assistant Secretary of Defense. In addition the Fiscal Year 1953 authorization is being re-evaluated.

2. The reorganization and realignment of functions within the Deputy Director (Plans) complex has resulted in changes in military personnel requirements for the remainder of Fiscal Year 1953 and for Fiscal Year 1954. This reorganization has delayed the submission of Fiscal Year 1954 requirements to the Defense Department and has rendered earlier requirement forecasts out of date.

3. In order that a completely current requirement for all of CIA may be developed and submitted it is requested that a re-evaluation of your military requirement be conducted. Results should be reported as soon as possible in two parts:

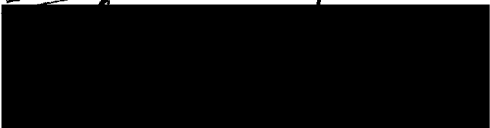
a. Adjustments to your current authorization that you require for the remainder of Fiscal Year 1953. Additional personnel, if required, should be specifically justified as a military requirement. Your current authorization is:

b. Your forecast of Fiscal Year 1954 requirements. The report you submitted in June 1952 which is attached may now be out of date. Resubmission is requested in order that your 1954 requirements, based on current information and plans, may be known and included in the overall CIA military requirement for Fiscal Year 1954 now being prepared.

4. When FY 1954 requirements are submitted to the Department of Defense, it may be necessary to provide additional justification for requirements in detail. You will be advised if this supporting information is needed.
