1. The Agency agreement with Mrs. Anna M. Rosenberg, Assistant Secretary of Defense, on policies covering assignment of military personnel to the Central Intelligence Agency provides that "Departure from a normal tour, in individual cases, will be limited to circumstances arising from . . . retention of highly specialized individuals whose reassignment adversely affects a critical operation . . ."

2. The facts presented in the referenced memorandum do not appear to warrant a request for extension of [redacted] tour within the intent of the above agreement. Unless there are considerations presently unknown to this Office which can be presented in support of such an extension, favorable action cannot be taken on your request.
