MEMORANDUM FOR: Comptroller  
SUBJECT: Uniform Allowance

1. The following was supplied to me by [redacted] as an extract from the Armed Forces Reserve Act of 1952:

"Uniform Allowance:

Hereafter, non-regular officers will be returned to an initial uniform allowance of \$200 and a maintenance allowance of \$50 for every four years of satisfactory inactive duty, and an active duty allowance of \$100 when ordered to active duty or active duty for training for a period of more than ninety days. This latter allowance of \$100 is retroactive for officers entering on active duty after June 25, 1950, but may not be paid unless two years have elapsed following a previous active duty tour for which the previous payment of this type was made."

2. If the above is correct, it would appear that we should make some adjustments in the allowances for reserve officers who are called to active duty for service with us. In [redacted] particular case, while he is not actually on active duty he is incurring the expenses necessary to purchase and maintain his military wardrobe to the same degree that he would be if he were on military duty.
