MEMORANDUM FOR: **THE ACTING DIRECTOR**

The morale problem [REDACTED] has become more aggravated because of necessary curfews and restrictions on social activities.

To alleviate this situation [REDACTED] recommends, and I concur, that the Agency provide funds for a "stay-at-home" entertainment program -- film library with 50 full length feature films and 150 short subjects and book library with 250 books. FY 56 estimated cost is \$20,000. Succeeding years not more than \$10,000.

Request you sign the attached memorandum which has been prepared by General Counsel authorizing this expenditure.
