The substance of discussion between the DTR and the faculty concerning the future of the OC and OFC has been reported in the COS Weekly Activities Report #43. Apparently the decision reached is that OC #11 and OFC #12 will be conducted as previously planned and scheduled, but that OC #12 and OFC #13 will be combined into one course beginning approximately September 1961. As I stated in my discussion with you this morning, I am completely opposed to this change in course content on the basis that the two courses were designed to satisfy the needs of different types of Agency employees and that in the proposed combination of courses the DDP/JOT will be the loser. The only advantage in combining these two courses, which I will concede, is the reduction in workload on the OC/OFC Staff. Rather than approach the problem from this point of view, I should suggest that you retain the two courses and by appropriate slot adjustment increase the number of instructors assigned to operational training
