1. [REDACTED] has been visiting Headquarters this week and has been consulting with OC Staffs regarding Middle East communications matters. He also is meeting with [REDACTED] to discuss mutual concerns regarding the pending station installation [REDACTED].

2. ARS: Because of software problems encountered during pre-acceptance testing [REDACTED], a delay of approximately six weeks in delivery of the [REDACTED] ARS is expected. If the contractor's initial estimate of slippage is correct, the installation [REDACTED] will start the week of 4 November 1974.

3. USIB: A representative from OC-E has been assigned as Chairman of the Communications Task Group for the Human Sources Committee of USIB. The group is charged with examining technical problems associated with development of secure telephonic conferencing among selected country teams and Washington Intelligence Community analysts.

4. AEC: The DD/CO met with a representative of AEC Communications who was interested in our capability to provide communications support to one of AEC's domestic projects. He was advised that we are not equipped to provide the assistance required.

5. KG-13's: Due to the continuing lack of suitable new crypto equipments from NSA, a decision has been made to try to acquire additional KG-13's from other Government agencies to meet the needs of the [REDACTED] and Secure Voice programs over the next several years. A cable request has been sent to the Director, NSA, asking their assistance in locating up to 400 units. Based on informal information that Air Force holds a large contingency stockpile of these units, a memorandum was also sent to Major General Edge, Director of Command Control and Communications, USAF, asking his assistance.

6. Senior Seminar: [REDACTED] Chief, OC-E, has been approved by the Training Selection Board to attend the Senior Seminar, 22 September through 27 November.
