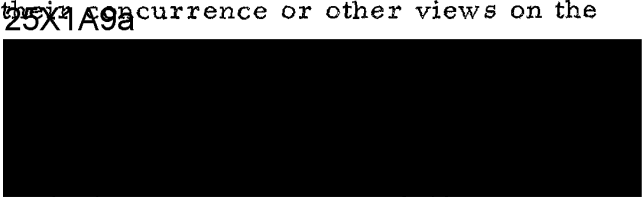

SUBJECT: National Intelligence Survey (NIS)  
Production Schedule for FY 1969



1. In accordance with the reference, the NIS Committee submits herewith the NIS Production Schedule for FY 1969.

2. The schedule reflects a transition to the production priorities established in the NIS coverage plan recently approved by the Board. A few units are included that are not shown on the plan; production processing on these was underway before the plan was approved.

3. Two pilot units on Social Characteristics -- a new element consolidating into a single volume the sociological coverage now provided in three separate volumes -- introduce a new concept that permits more efficient and effective presentation of supplementary sociological coverage in the NIS. The supplementary unit on Manpower is being phased out in favor of a somewhat expanded treatment of the subject in the more frequently revised General Survey.

4. Production units for FY 1969 total 385, a 10% reduction over that for FY 1968.


