formal request.

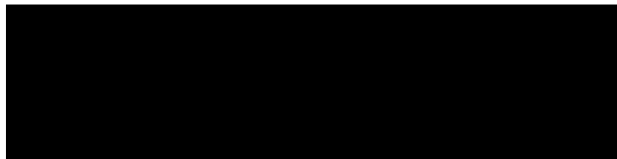
