Course Conduct

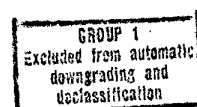
3. There were no changes in the presentation of the course.

6. There was an unusual amount of specialized experience evident in this class. The CSC Ts had already formed some ideas about biographic research in the short time they had been assigned to their desks. One, who is working for SB, asked permission to use the SPR form which is peculiar to that Division and produced an interesting variation on the usual dispatch. We also had two representatives from RID, whose combined experience with CS records totals twenty-four years. Miss [REDACTED] made valuable contributions to class discussion by explaining in precise detail what their offices could do. Mr. [REDACTED] handling of the practical exercise was one of the best in the group.
