4. Traditionally, the Navy has been the most uncooperative of our Defense contacts. We have found that each Navy office operated separately with individual rules. However, we have had more success in the last year.

For example, the Office of Naval Materiel has allowed us to use last minute cancellations in the Price Analysis and Contract Negotiation Course. 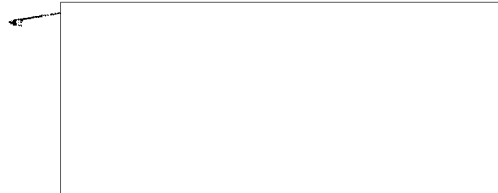

5. We have received 14 training requests from the Office of Computer Services to attend the ACM Systems Design Course sponsored by UNIVAC. The objective of the training is, "With the acquisition of third-generation hardware, it is important to become acquainted with new design concepts such as multi-programming and multi-processing." For this lecture series which began 10 March there are five GS-13's, five GS-12's, two GS-10's, three GS-9's, and one GS-7. Most of these employees are listed as systems analysts or analyst/programmers.

For the UNIVAC Compiler Design and Programming Language course, there are five requests ranging from GS-14 through GS-7.  GS-14, Chief, Technical Staff, OCS, is the only student for the Time Sharing Theory and Operation Course which also began in early March.
